The University of Kansas Health System St. Francis Campus New Life Center Visitation Policy

The New Life Center is concerned about each person's health and safety – especially <u>YOU</u> and your <u>BABY!</u> We ask for your help in following these guidelines.

- Anyone with a fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste, awaiting COVID-19 diagnostic results, those with a known recent exposure to a COVID-19 positive individual or anyone who has traveled to an identified hot-spot in the last 10 days will not be allowed entry.
- The main entrance (Entry A) closes daily at 7 P.M. After this time, visitors will need to enter through the Emergency Department.
- New Life Center allows 1 support person plus 2 visitors for labor and delivery. Post-Partum allows 1 support person plus 4 visitors at a time. Visitors must be over the age of 14. We kindly ask that the switching out of visitors happens outside of the unit and not in the patient's room. Siblings of the newborn, no matter their age, are allowed short visits during designated visiting hours. An adult over the age of 18 must accompany the child at all times. Children are not allowed to spend the night.
